

Unit Renewal

- Unit Renewal renews the Unit Leadership Roster. (along with the existing members)
- Member (Youth and Adult) Renewal takes places separately through each individual member completing their own annual registration. (This process happens when the membership expires after 12 months)

September 1st

Unit Renewal Tab becomes available.

October 17th

Deadline to complete Renewal





- The Chartered Organization Representative and Committee Chair can be the same person.
- The IH/Executive is a non-registered position (but can be registered into another adult position.






Step 2

How to Start Renewal:

- Unit Key 3 member (unit leader, chartered organization rep, committee chair) has access.
- Go to my.scouting.org
- > Home
- > Select Unit
- Select Organization (for the unit you are renewing)
- > (new page) Select Unit Renewal

Step 2 continued:

> Each time you open Unit Renewal, it automatically checks Validation:




Errors must be resolved:

- Adult with expired Safeguarding Youth training must renew training
- Incomplete Adult Roster (missing required leadership positions, page 3)

Step 2 Continued:

When errors with the adult roster are resolved, the charter can be signed (type your name). Now proceed to payment option.



Online unit renewal does require payment to complete:

- Unit Renewal Fee is \$100
- Options for payment:
 - Credit Card--3% fee or
 - E-Check (Bank Account Withdrawal) --\$1.00 fee

Make a Plan


Simple, Straightforward, Easy:

- Every member **renews themselves**—all Adult Leaders and Parent/Guardians will receive an email and text message to renew themselves and/or their Scouts.
- They should receive multiple email reminders prior to their membership expiration
 - Ensure they know to watch for these and that they aren't filtered to SPAM
- New for 2025! Text reminders for member renewal will be sent at 45 days prior to expiration


Not Simple, Straightforward and Easy (Not recommended)


- Unit Key 3 (unit leader, committee chair, or chartered organization rep) renew all or some of the youth (dependent on popcorn, fundraisers, etc).
- Chartered Organization Representative (or delegate) renews Adults.


my.scouting.org \rightarrow Organization Manager \rightarrow Roster, you can Opt-Out a member from renewing if you know they have left the unit.




Select member(s) to renew, then click on "Renew"









Renewals will be created and will be displayed under Membership Renewal Orders to be reviewed. If the renewals are still in an Initiated status, you are able to delete the record from this screen if needed. But if they are in a Submitted or Completed status, they cannot be deleted at this point—the payment has been received by national.




Review Unit Orders and the Unit Orders by Batch.


